Certification target

Video consultations are basically defined as synchronous communication between a doctor and a patient known to him, via the technical equipment available to the patient (peer-to-peer), if necessary with assistance, e.g. by a reference person, in the sense of an online video consultation in real time, which the doctor can offer the patient.

The certification target in terms of the technical procedure for video consultation according to Annex 31b to the Bundesmantelvertrag-Ärzte (BMV-Ä) is:

- Curameet (Version 1.4.16)

It consists of the telemedical function: implementation of online video consultations. The evaluation covers the certification target, the conduction of the video consultation (medical consultation) and its termination.

Not part of the certification target to be considered are:

- All functions and data processing that are not part of the tele-medical, synchronous peer-to-peer communication of the online video consultation.
- Chat function between doctor and patient
- Management of patient data in the Curalie patient management system
- Use of the video consultation solution Curameet with registration in the Curalie app
- Creation of a doctor's account and verification of the doctor's records by a health facility
- Accounting and billing systems on the part of the doctor
- Analysis services within the framework of the Curalie App
- Transmission of data from the booking process to Helios

According to the current definition of the video consultation, the functions mentioned as examples are not a core component of the online video consultation in real time within the framework of synchronous peer-to-peer communication and are therefore not part of the certification target. A separate information security assessment of the entire Curalie web applications is not carried out as part of the evaluation.
